

## The enCloud™ Management System

## **Account Development Module**

You can track your EN-400<sup>™</sup>, EN-1000<sup>™</sup>, EN-2000<sup>™</sup>, EN-3000<sup>™</sup>, and EN-4000<sup>™</sup> routers (EN<sup>™</sup> devices) via a direct connection to your computer, or over a LAN, or in several other ways, including through Encore Network's enCloud<sup>™</sup> management system.

The enCloud<sup>™</sup> system lets you track your network from anywhere with a connection to the internet. You can use a computer, a tablet, or a smartphone to track your devices. Development and use of enCloud<sup>™</sup> are discussed in the documents listed below.
