For the most part, $enSite^{TM}$ and $enCloud^{TM}$ function in identical ways. Most differences between $enSite^{TM}$ and $enCloud^{TM}$ concern system maintenance and similar functions. Differences are outlined in the document *Using the enSite^{TM} Standalone Server*.
